Description:

The building at 216 E. Lexington Street is an old structure which has a new facade. It is a three bay wide, three story high, brick structure with marble trim. The first story has a door on the ground level and a main entrance which has steps up to it. Above the ground level door there are two, one over one windows and on the right is the main, round arched, recessed entrance with brick steps. On the second and third stories are three, one over one windows. There is a simple aluminum cornice at the roofline and the building is in good condition.



This structure, like several others on this block of E. Lexington Street predates the Baltimore Fire of 1904. The building at 216 E. Lexington Street was built before 1885, except for the front facade which was redone in 1984-85. In 1911 the building was a saloon and it has had several other occupants throughout the 20th century. Overall the building is in good condition and although the facade is new it is compatible with the other buildings in the area.


