Description:

This six story high masonry block building is an addition to the Savings Bank of Baltimore. The eastern part of the facade is a large blank wall abutting the adjoining buildings on Baltimore Street. The western part of the facade which features an aluminum and glass entrance and windows recesses to the building walls of the Savings Bank of Baltimore. The entranceway is slightly recessed. It is surmounted by three part bronze aluminum single pane windows on the upper floors.

This building includes a bank machine at the Charles Center Metro Station below Baltimore Street. It was the first private building designed in conjunction with Baltimore's Metro. The materials and recessed design was an attempt to complement the adjacent Savings Bank of Baltimore building.
