## Description:

This four story high, seven bay wide structure is constructed of buff brick which has been recently cleaned. The three first floor storefronts have been altered to varying degrees, although the storefront at 109 East Baltimore Street seems the most original in appearance. Access to the upper floors is via the entrance at the westernmost bay of the first floor. The upper floor building walls are punctuated by one over one windows with splayed stone lintels and a shared stone sills. The stone modillion block cornice is surmounted by a parapet wall. A cigar store Indian (the last of its kind in downtown Baltimore) stands in front of Fader's cigar store at 107 East Baltimore Street.


This building has one of the widest facades on East Baltimore Street for a small building. It is a good commercial structure which has not been altered to a great degree above the first floor level. A 1914 photograph of the building shows the original first floor appearance and it may be possible to replicate the original design, which is fairly intact on one of the existing storefronts. This building is a contributing structure on East Baltimore Street.




