DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (If known) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This address was formerly two houses. The one to the left, previously 1110 N. Charles, is three bays wide and the other, once 1112 N. Charles, is one bay wide. They are both three and one half stories high, have rough granite block building walls, and high pitched gabled roofs with dormers. However, their adjacent first story facades have been altered to appear as one by accomodating the following elements: From left to right, a recessed flat plate glass double door is flanked by two large flat plate glass store windows which are seperated by a part of the original partition wall that has been sheathed in a polished surfacing material. An applied cornice directly above the entrance and windows lends visual unity to the first story facade and contrasts in color with the white rectangular tiles that cover most of the remaining first story facade and carry the "Miller Brothers" sign.

The remainder of this description treats the facades of each house seperately and refers to their former addresses as identification. The second story facade of 1110 is punctuated by three flat double hung windows with one over one lights, stone sills, and stone lintels that form a continous band across the facade and connects to an identically designed counterpart in 1112. The third story facade of 1110 is also punctuated by flat double hung windows with one over one lights and stone sills. The window to the right in this facade has a flat stone lintel. The two other lintels protrude slightly from the facade wall and each carry an element usually reserved for entrances, a tympanum. A frieze band is surmounted by a narrow cornice carrying dentals and supported by two brackets. A hipped roof dormer projects from the roof and is punctuated by two full arched double hung windows with one over one lights and stilted arch stone lintels.

The second and third story facades of 1112 are fenestrated with an oriel that continues into the half story to form a dormer. On both the second and third story facades the oriel houses three double hung flat windows with one over one lights, and stone sills and lintels that respectively form continous bands across the oriel and the facade, the latter banding being coincident to both houses. A narrow cornice carrying dentals and supported by brackets surmounts a decorative frieze band. The dormer carries two centered double hung flat windows with one over one lights and a stone sill and lintel flanked by two smaller single hung windows with stone sills and lintels to either side. The dormer roof appears conical in shape from the ground level and is supported by carved stone brackets.

Fenestration in both buildings is proportionally scaled and symetrically organized.



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



