DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The single story church has a natural stone facade which projects outward from the shingled upper gabled portion. The main, triangular-framed entrance has a centre pointed arch as outlined for the doorway and transom.

The first story stained glass window has a plain stone lintel and lugsill. The second story window at the centre of the shingled gable, is also stained glass but with plain surround.

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

The Zion Lutheran church at 32nd and Barclay Street was built with the purpose of meeting the needs of the Negro religious community. The building was located across the street from School Number 115, which consisted of a one story frame building and a larger, two story one. In total, the school provided six classrooms. A 1903 record for the school titles it the "Colored High and Training School" taught by an all colored faculty. The buildings are no longer standing.

The church and school probably serviced the community during the very late nineteenth and early twentieth century. The church is still however, central to the small community which surrounds it. Most of the homes on Barclay, between 31st and 33rd Streets are owned by blacks and it would be conceivable that the homes originally were also owned by blacks.



