5.	<u>GENERAL ACCOUNTING RECORDS</u> Office copies of : Goods received memoranda, bill invoices, expense and travel reports, requisitions, petty cash vouchers, mileage reports, direct payment records, paid bills, ticket books, purchase orders, deposit slips, receipt books, checking reconciliations, bank statements etc..
