



BOSTON STREET IN 1849

"...The undersigned Citizens of Baltimore respectfully state...the mail trains...daily arriving in this City...are driven through Boston Street from Canton Avenue to the Eastern line...by steam power at the rate of from sixteen to eighteen miles an hour...our city is fraught with fearful peril to the life and limbs...That said line is through out the day the great Eastern thorough fare of the City & continually crowded with carts, waggins, horses, carriages & pedestrians..."


Where to Start







