150 Years of Emancipation in Maryland

On November 1, 1864, the state of Maryland ratified its 3rd constitution. Article 24 of the constitution declared, "*That hereafter in this state, there shall be neither slavery nor involuntary servitude, except in punishment of crime, whereof the party shall have been duly convicted: and all persons held to service or labor as slaves are hereby declared free.*"
