Session 3	<p>PQ 3.1—The Response Coordinator’s responsibilities include:</p> <p>Answer choices:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">– Assigning Response Team members to teams– Providing the team with health and safety precautions– Setting priorities based on information received from the assessment of the Assessment Team– All of the above <p>Correct answer: All of the above</p> <p>PQ 3.2—True or false? If the incident is small-scale—for example, 10 or fewer boxes of records—a tracking system does not need to be implemented.</p> <p>Answer choices:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">– True– False <p>Correct answer: False</p> <p>PQ 3.3—What should you do if you are denied access to damaged records for more than 48 hours?</p> <p>Answer choices:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">– Give up and cancel all response/recovery efforts. After 48 hours the records are damaged beyond repair, so there’s no point in recovering them.– Forcibly enter the area where the damaged records are located and begin response/recovery actions.
