Please note: There are no actual marriage certificates before the year 1915. The marriage record before 1915 consists of a single line entry in a marriage record book giving the names of the bride and groom, the date, and sometimes the name of the officiant. Marriage licenses were required for whites (but not for African Americans) to marry in Maryland beginning in 1776, but do not necessarily prove that the marriage occurred. Marriage records, 1865-1884, do prove a marriage for whites and for African Americans after 1867, but were inconsistently recorded.
