CHAPTER 1.

AN ACT to authorize the Governor to appoint an assistant to the Secretary of State.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the Governor be and he is hereby authorized and empowered, in case of the sickness or absence of the Secretary of State, to appoint, temporarily, an assistant to the Secretary of State, who is hereby empowered to discharge all the duties inposed by law upon said Secretary, during his illness or absence from the seat of government; and the Governor is authorized to pay, out of the Executive Contingent Fund, for such services a salary not exceeding one hundred and fifty dollars per month.
