MRS. MARY CHURCH TERRELL

(One of Our Foremost Scholars, Thinkers, Orators)

Here is a woman richly endowed by nature for a great work to which she has grandly devoted all her endowments. Either as orator or debater she has few equals, yet her success was achieved by incessant labor in a most unobtrusive manner.

After graduating from Oberlin College she taught at the Wilberforce University and was teacher of languages in the Washington Colored High School. Then she spent several years abroad, perfecting herself in German, French and Italian, and on her return was offered a position on the faculty of Oberlin College.

At this time, however, she married Robert H. Terrell, a graduate of Harvard, then Chief of a Division in the Treasury Department, and later one of the Federal judges of the District of Columbia.

Thereafter, Mrs. Terrell devoted her highly developed faculties to the cause of education, serving on the Board of Trustees of the Public Schools and on the Board of Education. Mrs. Terrell was the first colored woman to serve on a Board of Education in this country and was re-appointed again and again until she served eleven years—longer than the service of any person, white or colored, on the Board of Education in our National Capital.

Mrs. Terrell was the only one of the American delegates to the International Congress of Women in Berlin some years ago who addressed the convention in German. She followed it by an address in French. It carried the audience literally by storm, and she was recalled three times.

Mrs. Terrell has received glowing tributes from editors and authors, far too numerous to mention. From the dean of Harvard, after an address before Radcliffe College students, she was described as having a good presence, an agreeable and refined voice, an excellent command of language, a manner neither too diffident nor self-assured, and a touch of that eloquence which seems to go with even the least infusion of African blood. From the president of the Christian Association of Wellesley College after an address made there, Mrs. Terrell received a communication praising her in the highest words possible as a result of the wide discussion her subject had created among the girls in the college.

Hardly enough can be said of Mrs. Terrell's excellence and superiority. She speaks without notes; she stands self-possessed, master of any situation; she appeals to eye, ear and heart alike in satisfying and convincing manner; she exhibits burning eloquences, tempered by a broad education.

INTRODUCTORY

One of the great differences between modern civilization and the ages that have gone before is to be noted in the use by many men of information compiled and published by one of their number. It is impossible to make even an approximate estimate of the time and energy saved to the human race by the application of such a process in modern life. Little by little men have learned the value of organization and co-operation, and have understood how to make use of the labors of their fellows, and today the extent to which this is done in any group or community is an accurate index of the state of advancement of that group.

For a long time after the Civil War the colored people in this country were "hewers of wood and drawers of water," and their business and industrial life was of the simplest kind. As the years passed slight changes were noted, and in very recent years the change has been most rapid, especially in the great urban centers. One of the recognized accompaniments of modern commercial and professional life and organization is the directory. In 1820 Bradstreet first published his famous commercial directory in New York. Thirteen years ago the publisher of this work thought he saw the need of a directory for the colored business, professional and educational world of Baltimore, and later included other cities. That his thought was a good one is evidenced by the fact that in the years intervening between 1913 and the current year 12 editions of this work have been published, and similar works have been compiled for other cities with large colored populations, in imitation of Mr. Coleman's idea.

One of the very interesting things about this directory is its compiler, himself well known in the cities which figure in its pages. Mr. Robert W. Coleman comes of good stock, being the son of Sergeant A. B. Coleman, who, associated with the younger Frederick Douglass, helped to organize the colored regiments in Massachusetts during the dark days of the Civil War, and for this service received the thanks of the legislature of Boston. He is a brother of Mr. John H. Coleman, a prominent business man of Chicago, and a cousin of Judge Robert H. Terrell, formerly of the Municipal Court, Washington, D. C. He married Miss Mary A. Mason, of Baltimore, who has been an indispensable figure in the life and activities of Mr. Coleman.

Stricken, after he reached adult manhood, with almost complete blindness, Mr. Coleman, though weighed down by the responsibility for the care of a large family showed the stuff that was in him by learning a new trade, that of piano-tuning, and in his odd hours, at certain seasons of the year, collecting the advertising and other material for his directory in the cities concerned. His energy, courage and perseverance, under such a handicap, have been little short of marvelous. Mr. Coleman is a graduate of the Business Department of M Street High School, Washington. In his later years under the administration of Rev. Williams' secretary, he was a member of the board of directors of the Baltimore branch of the Y. M. C. A.

The directory idea, in this new age of progress and expansion among the colored people, is capable of almost indefinite extension, and its possibilities are unlimited. It is our hope that the originator of the idea may some day realize his most ambitious dreams concerning it. With the assistance of and co-operation of the communities involved, not only in the way of advertising, but also in the furnishing of complete and accurate information, there is no reason why he should not do this, for the enterprise is certainly deserving of the most hearty and generous support of the public.

P. S.—Mr. Coleman is assisted in the editing of this directory by his second daughter, Miss Dorothy.



DR. J. O. SPENCER (White)

President John Oakley Spencer comes of fine old New England stock. On his father's side he is descended directly from the Lymans famous in the earliest history of that section, while through his mother he is connected with a Scotch Klan that runs far back into the records of Scotland, some of whom early in the Seventeenth Century came to America and settled partly in Vermont, partly in northern New York.

President Spencer was born July 11, 1857, at Lemon, Wyoming County, Pennsylvania. He attended the public schools of that section, and when ready entered Wyoming Seminary, an institution noted at that time for the superior training it gave to the youth who entered it. After completing his course there he taught in the public schools of northern Pennsylvania and New York for some time. He was Principal of Sherbourne Academy and was the organizer of the high school at Kingston, Pa.

After a college career at Illinois Wesleyan University he went to Japan, where for 15 years he had distinguished success as the Dean of the Anglo-Japanese College at Tokio. He then returned to America to engage in special study at Columbia University and rounded out his university life with the doctorate from Illinois Wesleyan University. His intention to return to Japan was overruled by the great loss sustained in the death of his wife and one of his sons.

Dr. Spencer then became the Headmaster of the Hudson River Academy from which position he was called in 1902 to the Presidency of Morgan College. For the last 23 years he has guided the course of this institution, and in that time has seen it go from its crowded quarters on Fulton and Edmondson Avenues, and an enrollment that was very meagre, into a spacious and beautiful suburban location of more than sixty acres, and into a student body that is limited now only by the capacity of its present equipment. He has seen it become recognized as a first class college, whose graduates are admitted at the best of American Universities for advanced study. He has seen the sentiment of this community change from one of indifference and incredulity to one that gives it position and prestige among its patrons such as is held by institutions of similar high grade in their several communities.

To the accomplishment of these results President Spencer has given the best of his life and thought and consecrated purpose. Despite criticism from both sides of the color line occasional questioning of his sincerity and at times open hostility he has gone straight ahead until now he is loved and respected by all citizens of this community who believe that the fullest and highest opportunities for the development of the intellectual powers of all men must be provided. In all these endeavors he has been nobly aided by Mrs. Spencer, whom he married in 1907, and who has been a remarkable influence in widening his vision and deepening his resolve to give all that he had to the promotion of an institution of higher learning for the negro, until there shall not be a better one anywhere in this country.

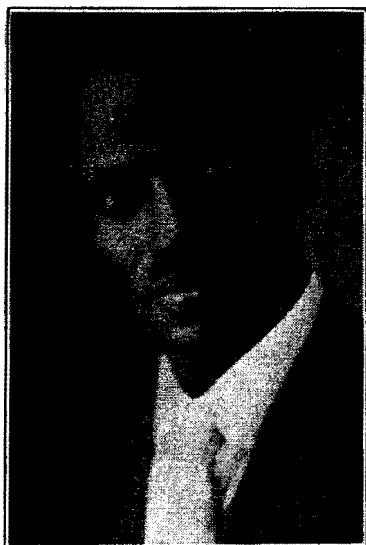

PROFESSOR FRANCIS M. WOOD

The subject of this sketch, Francis M. Wood, was born in Barren County, Kentucky, and received his early educational training in the common schools of that State. During the first few years of his life, he lived on a farm with his parents, where he attended the rural schools of that section. He was educated in the common schools of Kentucky, afterwards attending other institutions as the State Normal School, Frankfort, Kentucky; Terre Haute College, Terre Haute, Indiana; Eckstein College, Kentucky, and the School of Education at Hampton Institute, Hampton, Virginia. His experience includes three years in the rural schools; three years in the city graded schools and twelve years principal of the Western High School in Paris, Kentucky, and one year as supervisor of all the schools (colored) of Kentucky and one year as president of the Kentucky Normal and Industrial, Frankfort, Kentucky.

It is but fitting to say that Mr. Wood has held every important position in Kentucky open to men of his race. For many years he was connected in an official way with the State Department of Education, Frankfort, Kentucky, as Rosenwald agent, and as supervisor of schools. Dr. George Colvin, State Superintendent of Public Instruction, has this to say of him: "If harmonious relations are to be worked out between the two races without exploiting the colored race, Wood is the type of leadership that must be secured. I believe in him absolutely, and respect him both for his character and his capacity." Dr. F. C. Button, President of the State Normal School at Moorehead, Kentucky, says of him: "He is a man of fine spirits, and he is respected by both races. He is teachable, but not servile."

"This last signal honor that has come to Mr. Wood is more significant because it has come to him without any effort on his own part. This honor will be hailed with joy by his legion of friends in Kentucky, black and white, who have always backed him in any work he has undertaken."

Dr. James Bond, of Louisville, Director of the Inter-Racial Commission of Kentucky, has this to say of Mr. Wood, "No man in Kentucky of the Negro race has been more highly honored than has Mr. Wood. He was president of the Kentucky Negro Educational Association for ten years, where he built up a very fine organization that now has a membership of over 1,200 teachers. For this splendid service the teachers of Kentucky gave him a trip West, where he was enabled to observe many of the best schools open to his people. As director of the Rosenwald Fund of Kentucky, Mr. Wood made an enviable record by the splendid school building program which he promulgated for the Kentucky schools. He is one of the men of our race who has been able to secure the confidence and co-operation of both black and white people without exploiting his own race and without sacrificing his manhood."

"On July 9th last he was elected supervisor of all the colored schools of Baltimore City, Baltimore, Maryland.

"If Mr. Wood carries with him the same energy, enthusiasm and educational spirit to Baltimore, that has characterized his work in Kentucky, and we have every reason to believe that he will, success is sure to crown his efforts. He leaves Kentucky of his own free will, giving up one of the best educational positions in the State and carrying with him the confidence and good will of the people whom he has served so long and so well."

"I have known Mr. Wood for some fifteen years or twenty years, the last ten years intimately, and it gives me great satisfaction to say that he is a man of outstanding character and attainments. He is easily the outstanding educator among the colored people of Kentucky, where as principal of some of our leading high schools, President of the Kentucky Negro Educational Association and lately President of our State Normal and Teachers College at Frankfort, he has done a remarkable piece of constructive educational work for our State."

PROFESSOR MASON A. HAWKINS

Principal of Million-and-Half-Dollar High School.



Professor Mason A. Hawkins, principal of the Frederick-Douglass Senior-Junior High School, was born at Charlottesville, Virginia, but has spent the greater part of his life in Baltimore.

His elementary training was received in the public schools of Baltimore. His secondary work was done at Morgan College, 1893-1897. He received his Bachelor of Arts degree from Harvard University in 1901 after four years of study, and the Master of Arts degree from Columbia University, and Master's Diploma from Teachers' College, Columbia, in 1910. He took a Teachers' Course in Latin at Johns Hopkins University, and a course in Conversational German at the local Berlitz School in 1903. He is a member of the American Academy of Political and Social Science; Fellow of the American Geographical Society; member of

Union Baptist Church. He has several inventions for which United States patents have been granted. In 1901 he became a member of the first Colored faculty of the Douglass High School; head of the Department of Foreign Languages in 1906; acting vice-principal, February, 1909, and principal from 1909 to the present time.

For many years Professor Hawkins has taken an active interest in social activities, and is much interested in music.

In October, 1905, Professor Hawkins married Margaret B. Gregory, daughter of the late Professor James M. Gregory, who was instructor in Latin at Howard University for twenty years, and then principal for eighteen years of the Manual Training School at Bordentown, N. J. Professor and Mrs. Hawkins have two sons, Gregory and Mason, Jr.

Among the educators of the country, Professor Hawkins holds a unique place. Under his guidance and untiring efforts, Baltimore today has one of the finest secondary school buildings to be found anywhere in the country, and her graduates are accepted by many of the leading colleges and universities without examination.



REV. C. HAROLD STEPTEAU, D. D.

Rev. C. Harold Stepteau, D. D., who was recently appointed the pastor of Baltimore's largest and most popular church, Bethel A. M. E. Church, Lanvale and Druid Hill avenue, was born in Lynchburg, Va. The son of William Harrison and Matilda J. Stepteau, both parents were members of the A. M. E. Church, and early in life saw to it that their son was given the advantages of an early Christian training; he is the oldest of seven children.

Dr. Stepteau comes to Bethel Church with a long line of successful pastorates, he has served from the smallest mission points to the largest congregations. His first appointment in the Baltimore Conference was Shorter Mission, D. C. Before coming to the Baltimore Conference he served in the Louisiana Conference, from there he was appointed as missionary to Cuba under the late Rt. Rev. C. Spencer Smith, D. D., returning to the States he was married to Miss Estell V. Lyons of Baton Rouge, La., to this union two children were born—C. Harold, Jr., and Zerita Mae, both of whom are graduates of the Douglass High School.

Dr. Stepteau has been among the first and foremost in this city in the advocacy of the right and privileges of his people and can always be counted on when great issues are at stake.

Baltimore counts on him as one of her most dependable men. He has served the following charges:

Bethel Church, Baton Rouge, La., the home of his wife. Ebenezer, Baltimore, from there he was appointed Presiding Elder of the Potomac District, serving five years. Then he was appointed pastor of Metropolitan, Washington, D. C., Allen, Baltimore, then Presiding Elder of the Baltimore District for three years, from which responsible position he was appointed to the important work of Bethel A. M. E. Church, this city.

We bespeak for Dr. Stepteau a most successful pastorate at this church and hope the General Church will see him in his true light as we Baltimoreans do, and call him to the highest place in the gift of his church where he deserves to be.

With his aimable wife and intelligent children he will reflect credit upon the church in any capacity.

Dr. Stepteau is a graduate of Wilberforce University.



MR. C. J. DAVIS

Carrington Lewis Davis was born August 27, 1879, in Green Spring Valley, Baltimore County, Maryland. After completing the course of the public school at his home he entered the Academy of Morgan College in October, 1894, from which department he graduated in June, 1897. He entered the Freshman class of the college department the following autumn and was graduated as Valedictorian of his class in June, 1901, at the same time winning the Charles W. Baldwin medal for excellence in English oratory. After spending one year as instructor at Morgan, Mr. Davis entered Harvard University in the fall of 1902 and was graduated in 1904. During his Senior year he was elected a member of the Harvard Classical Club, being the only colored man so elected up to this time.



E. BERNARD TAYLOR

E. B. Taylor, a well-known Baltimore caterer, began his business career as clerk for the famous caterer, Bowen, while still a school boy. Notwithstanding the many reverses which come to every business man, he has mastered them manfully. He is a man of pleasing manner, sociable, businesslike and easy to approach. Mr. Taylor has always shown a deep interest in the welfare of all interests toward his race and still stands ready to co-operate with his fellowmen.



W. EMMETT COLEMAN

This young man, who has been in charge of the North Carolina Mutual Insurance Co., in the State of Maryland, for the last three years, announces very substantial gains in the insurance world. Its phenomenal growth can be attributed to an unequalled agency force, and the whole-hearted co-operation of the business men of Maryland. Whiting, Executive Secretary of the Druid Hill Branch of the Young Women's Christian Association, is a native of Gallipolis, Ohio, and a graduate of the High School of that city and of Duff's Business College, of Pittsburg, Pa., having done post-graduate work at Chautauqua, New York; Chicago, Illinois; Ypsilanti, Michigan, and Columbia University, New York City. Miss Whiting was a successful teacher in the city schools of Gallipolis, Ohio, and of Covington, Kentucky, and resigned from the latter place to enter the work of the Young Women's Christian Association during the World's War, receiving her training at Louisville, Kentucky and the National Training School at New York.

She had charge of the Hostess House at Camp Funston, Kansas, at which post she remained until the Armistice was

signed. The past six years and a half have been spent in Detroit, Michigan, where she has built up a large and successful Young Women's Christian Association Branch. Miss Whiting is an earnest church worker and deeply interested in the civic and social conditions of her people.

Rev. John Wesley McCoy, D.D.

Pastor of Big Zion Church

Rev. John Wesley McCoy, D. D., the popular pastor of Big Zion, Pennsylvania avenue, Baltimore, Md., the son of Jacob and Mary McCoy, was born in Harnett County, North Carolina. He secured his early education by attending the local schools and later entered Hampton Institute, Hampton, Va., where he remained three years. He was converted in 1881 at Andrews' Chapel, now St. Peter's A. M. E. Zion Church, New Bern, N. C. Licensed to preach in Fleet Street A. M. E. Zion Church, Brooklyn, N. Y., in 1895. Joined the New York Conference 1896; was ordained Deacon in May, 1896; ordained Elder by Bishop Hood at Mother Zion, New York City, in 1899. He has successfully pastored Oyster Bay, N. Y., Fishkill, N. Y., Middletown, N. Y., Mamaroneck, N. Y., where he remained seven years and built a beautiful church; St. Augustine Kinston, N. C.; Clinton Chapel, New Bern, N. C.; Union, Ralph Avenue, Brooklyn, N. Y., Troy, N. Y., Tarrytown, N. Y. He is now closing up his ninth year at Big Zion, Baltimore. He has been a prominent delegate to all of the General Conferences of his church since 1904.

In 1924 his name was mentioned for Bishop of his church. In 1912 Barrett College of North Carolina conferred the Degree of Doctor of Divinity, of which he wears with honor to himself and race.

His first wife died in 1913; remarried in 1921 to Miss M. Etta Cofield, of Enfield, N. C. By this union they have been blest with two beautiful children, Lillian Juanita and John Wesley, Jr.
