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WILLIAM PICKENS

WILLIAM PICKENS was born in Anderson County, S. C. When he was seven years of age, his parents moved to Arkansas, where he was graduated from the Union High School in Little Rock as the valedictorian of his class.

From the high school he entered Talladega College in Alabama and finished the Bachelor of Arts course, after which he entered Yale University where he received the degree of A. B., the Phi Beta Kappa Key, and rank in the Philosophical Oration group, the highest ranking group in the class. In his career as a teacher he received the following honors: A diploma from the British Esperanto Association; the Master of Arts degree from Fisk University; the Litt. D. from Selma University, and LL. D. from Wiley University.

After teaching foreign languages and other subjects in Talladega College for ten years, he spent one year in Wiley University as head of the department of Greek and Sociology. He was then elected as Dean of Morgan College in Baltimore where he served for five years, being Vice-President in the last two years. On February 1, 1929, he resigned from educational work to take a position with the National Association for the Advancement of Colored People.

He has made many trips to Europe to attend conferences and deliver lectures in England, Scotland, Germany, Poland, Russia, Switzerland and Austria.

Mr. Pickens is the author of "The Heir of Slaves", an autobiography; "The New Negro", a collection of essays; "The Vengeance of the Gods", short stories; "Bursting Bonds", auto-biographical; and "American Aesop", after-dinner stories. Co-author of "What I Owe to My Father".

He is well known as an orator and contributor to the press and leading periodicals, and is contributing editor of the Associated Negro Press.

He was a member of the Niagara Movement which antedated the N. A. A. C. P., and he is a member of the Omega Psi Phi.

He served as Forum Leader in the Federal Forum Projects (U.S. Department of the Interior) during 1937 and 1938.

May 15, 1941, at request of the Treasury Department of the United States, he began work with the Defense Savings Staff. In 1942 he was designated as Chief of the Interracial Section, the National Organizations Division of the Treasury.

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WALTER T. DIXON

Walter T. Dixon, Dean of the Cortez W. Peters Business School, was formerly in charge of the total Junior College when that Institution was begun under the Federal Government.

Mr. Dixon has been engaged in the field of education for a number of years and has served in the Public Schools of Washington, D. C., and on the faculty of the North Carolina College for Negroes in Durham, N. C.

Columbia University has conferred both the Bachelor's and Master's degrees upon Mr. Dixon. He is also a graduate of Benedict College, Howard University, American School of Law, and Central College of Chiropractic.

The local Business School, the only one of its kind in the State for the training of Negro youth for Commercial activities, has made remarkable progress and has placed a great number of its graduates in lucrative positions.

Mr. Dixon is a member of the Governor's Commission on Problems affecting the Negro Population. He will serve until the first Monday in June, 1945.

Mr. Dixon is a 32nd Degree Mason, an Odd Fellow, and at the present time is vice-president of the graduate Chapter of the Alpha Phi Alpha Fraternity.

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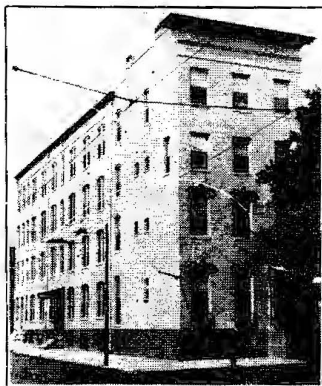
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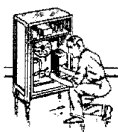
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LYONS, JUDSON WHITLOCKE—Lawyer. Born Burke Co., Ga. August 15, 1860. L.L.B. Howard U. 1884. Admitted to bar 1884, practiced in Augusta, Ga. Married Jane Hope 1890. Registrar U. S. Treasury 1898-1906. Member of Republican National Committee. Trustee and President Haines Normal Inst., Augusta. Died June 22, 1924.

NAPIER, JAMES CARROLL—Lawyer. Born near Nashville June 9, 1845, son of free negroes. Educated Wilburforce, Oberlin & Howard Law School. 1872. Married 1878 Nettie Langston. Negro leader in civic and economic affairs in Tenn. Helped organize One Cent Savings Bank, now known as Citizens Bank and Trust Co. of which cashier until his death April 21, 1940. Register of U. S. Treasury 1911-1913. Refused appointment as consul to Brazil and Consul-General to Liberia. Housing project in Nashville named for him.

VERNON, WILSON TECUMSEH—Bishop. Born July 11, 1871 Lebanon, Missouri. Educated Lincoln U. 1886-1889. Also Wilburforce U. D.D. and L.L.D. Married Emily Embry 1901. Pres. Western U. in Kansas 1896-1906. Registrar of U. S. Treasury 1906-1910. Supervisor of government schools 1911-1912. Pres. Campbell College in Mississippi 1912-1915. Pastor of Avery Chapel A. M. E. Church, Memphis. Elected to Bishopric 1920. Author of "Uplifting of a Race" and "Democracy and the Negro." Died July 25, 1944.

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
