

And thereupon the said Negro Mary by her
Attorney aforesaid sued out of Frederick
County Court here a writ of Subpoena in the
following words, to wit, Frederick County
to wit, The State of Maryland To the
Sheriff of Frederick County greeting you are
heresby commanded to summon Otto
Spigg that all excuses and delays set aside
he be and appear before the Judges of the next
County Court to be held at the Court house in
Frederick Town in and for the County aforesaid
on the first monday in February next to answer
the petition of Negro Mary in the said Court
against him exhibited for her freedom hereof
he is not to fail and fail you not and have
you then and there this writ Witness John
Buchanan Esquire chief Judge of the said
Court the 5th day of August 1811. Issued the

At which said first monday in February in
the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred
and twelve being the day of the return of the
aforegoing writ comes into Court here the said
