

and sworn to say the truth in the premises  
between the parties aforesaid within joined  
upon their oath do say that the said Negro  
Mary is free in manner and form as by  
her petition aforesaid she hath alleged  
Therefore it is considered by the  
Court here that the said Negro Mary the  
petitioner aforesaid recover her freedom  
of and against the said Otto Sprigg and  
that she be free and discharged of and  
from the service of the said Otto Sprigg  
and that she the said Negro Mary go there  
of free and discharged without day &c.  
It is also considered by the Court here  
that the said Negro Mary recover against  
the said Otto Sprigg the sum of one dollar  
and sixty cents and four hundred and ninety three pounds of Tobacco  
by the Court here unto the said Negro Mary  
adjudged on her account for her costs  
and charges by her about the prosecuti-  
on of her petition aforesaid laid
