the year of our Lord eighteen hundred and
thirteen the above named Negro Mary by
the judgment of the same Court recovered
against the above bound Otto Spigg her
freedom from Slavery and Costs of suit
from which said judgment so as aforesaid
recovered the said Otto Spigg hath prayed
an appeal to the next Court of Appeals to
be held for the Western shore on the first
Monday in December next Now the Condition
of the above obligation is such that if the
above bound Otto Spigg shall not pursue
the directions of the act of Assembly entitled
"An act for regulating writs of error and
granting appeals from and to the Courts
of common law within this province" at
the next Court of appeals to be held for the
Western shore and prosecute the same
appeal with effect and also satisfy and pay
unto the said Negro Mary her executors
administrators or assigns in case the said
judgment shall be affirmed all and
