

2. The sum of three hundred and fifty dollars  
current money to be levied of his body goods  
and chattels lands and tenements to and  
for the use of the said State On Condition  
that he the said Otho Sprigg do not remove  
the said Negro Josely out of this State nor  
obstruct him from attending this Court  
from time to time to support his petition  
for freedom aforesaid and in the mean  
time to feed cloath and use him well and  
pay whatever satisfaction the Court shall  
adjudge for the services of the said Negro  
Josely from this term to the time of the  
judgment and costs and on motion of  
the said Negro Josely by his Attorney aforesaid  
said it is ruled by the Court here that the  
said Otho Sprigg answer to the petition  
of the said Negro Josely in the plea aforesaid  
and unless he doth judgment of the  
Court will be rendered against him in  
default thereof and the said Otho Sprigg  
by Roger B. Taney his Attorney defend  
the force and injury and so forth and pay
