to be made we bind our selves and every of us
our and every of our heirs executors and admi-
nistrators jointly and severally firmly by
these presents sealed with our seals and
dated this 25th day of August in the year of
our Lord eighteen hundred and thirteen
Whereas at a County Court begun and hold at
Frederick Town in and for Frederick County on
the first Monday of August in the year of our
Lord eighteen hundred and thirteen the above
named Negro Swooly by the judgment of the
said Court recovered against the above bound
Otho Sprigg his freedom from slavery and
costs of suit from which said judgment so as
aforesaid rendered the said Otho Sprigg hath
prayed an appeal to the next Court of Appeals
to be hold for the Western shore on the first
Monday in December next Now the condition
of the above obligation is such that if the
above bound Otho Sprigg shall not pursue
the directions of the act of Assembly entitled
"An act for regulating writs of error and granting
appeals from and to the Courts of common Law
