an axe, and a spinning wheel and cards, Cotton Cards and one iron pot holding three gallons or thereabouts, and half a dozen pewter plates, and the balance of the wool after clothing the family, and one young white sow and all the dunghill fowls, and half a barrel of wheat, also it is my will and desire that my man Jonas, her son be the entire right and property of her the said Anna. Item, I give and bequeath unto Hanson Burrough's five children, and Hazeukiah Woodburn son of Jonathan Woodburn all my property not otherwise disposed of, to be equally divided amongst them. Lastly I do hereby constitute and appoint my friend John MacWilliams sole Executor of this my last will and Testament, ratifying and confirming this and none other to be my last will and Testament. I Testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this twelfth day of September Anno Domini one thousand eight hundred and eleven.
