No it remembered that heretofore Court on the second Tuesday of May being the eleventh day of the said month in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and two the chief Justice and associate Justice of the third Judicial District in pursuance of an act of Assembly in such case made and provided transmitted to the late General Court the record of proceedings of a cause which was lately depending before them in the County Court held in and for Baltimore County between John and Margaret Hay Plaintiff and Walter Conner Defendant and whereas the said County Court gave Judgment for the said Walter Conner against the said John and Margaret Hay and from whose Judgment the said John and Margaret Hay appealed unto the said late General Court the tenor of which said record of proceedings is in few following lines.

Baltimore County the 4th of County Court of the third Judicial district of the State of Maryland held at the Court house in the City of Baltimore in and for the County aforesaid on the first Monday in February in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and two.

John Hay and Margaret Hay against Walter Conner

No it remembered that heretofore Court on the fourth day of June in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred; John Hay and Margaret Hay by Nicholas Price their attorney met out of the County Court house the town of the State of Maryland of Capias ad responsum against Walter Conner directed to the Sheriff of Baltimore County in few following words State of Maryland to the Sheriff of Baltimore County

Greeting We command you that you take Walter Conner late of Baltimore County if he shall be found in your jurisdiction and that him so taken you safely keep so that you have his body before the Justices of Baltimore County Court at the Court house in the same County on the first Monday in September next to answer unto John Hay and Margaret Hay of a p[ro]c[ess] of trespass upon the said and respite thereof had not (fifty cents) at your hands and have you there and then also with witness Henry (com. rec'd) Ridgely Gentleman chief Justice of our said Court the 3rd day of May instant.
