At which said first Monday in September in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred, Come into the County Court here the said John Hay and Margaret Hay by their attorney aforesaid and the Sheriff of Baltimore County to whom the said aforesaid writ was in form aforesaid directed under return thereof to the Court here that he hath taken the body of the said Walter Conner to answer unto the said John Hay and Margaret Hay as by the said writ he was commanded.

Whereupon the said Walter Conner by Hebulon Hollingsworth and John Purviance his attorneys appear in Court here and defend; the force and injury where and soforth and prays leave of the Court here to appear unto the Wednesday after the first Monday in April next and to him it is granted the same day is given to the said John Hay and Margaret Hay also.

At which said Wednesday after the first Monday in April in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and one, Come again into the County Court here as well the said John Hay and Margaret Hay by their attorney aforesaid as the said Walter Conner by his attorneys aforesaid, whereupon on motion of the said Walter Conner by his attorneys aforesaid it is ruled by the Court here that the said John Hay and Margaret Hay declare against the said Walter Conner in the plea aforesaid on Judgment by the Court here well to rendered against them in default thereof. Whereupon the said John Hay and Margaret Hay by their attorney aforesaid pray leave of the Court here to appear unto the first Monday in September next and to them it is granted the same day is given to the said Walter Conner also.

At which said first Monday in September in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and one Come again into the County Court here as well the said John Hay and Margaret Hay by their attorney aforesaid as the said Walter Conner by his attorneys aforesaid as the said Walter Conner whereupon the said John Hay and Margaret Hay by their attorney aforesaid declared against the said Walter Conner in the plea aforesaid in form following to wit.

Baltimore County vs Walter Conner late of Baltimore County was attached to answer unto John Hay and Margaret Hay of a plea of trespass upon the case and soforth; And whereupon the said John and Margaret who are infants under the ages of twenty one years by Robert Saunders their next friends Complain that whereas they the said John and Margaret on the first day of December seventeen

hundred
