Dear Sir:-

Your favor of the 2nd inst. to hand. By Section 36 of the City Charter, it is provided that "in case of any surplus arising in any fiscal year, by reason of an excess of income received from the

estimated revenue over the expenditures for such year, the said surplus shall be passed to the Commissioners of Finance to be credited to the general sinking fund". There should in my opinion be no evasion of the requirements of this, or any other, section of the Charter, and my advice to you is to pursue the same administrative course with refer-

ence to December as any other monthly receipts.
