Under the terms of Section 110 of Article 23 of the Code of Public General Laws, gas light companies are authorized to pay their pipes "under the streets, squares, lanes, alleys and roads" of the City, but these terms are not broad enough, in my opinion, to include Druid Hill Park, and I know of no other provisions of the Public General or Public Local Laws to which argument could possibly refer an alleged right of the Consolidated Gas Company of Baltimore City to lay a gas main in Druid Hill Park.

The language of Section 91 of the New City Charter, which declares that the Park Board shall have charge and control of all public parks, squares, springs and monuments belonging to, controlled by, or in the custody of the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore is, of course, very comprehensive, but latitudinous as it is, the dominion conferred by it is necessarily, in my opinion, limited to purposes of a public nature.
