twenty-three feet ten inches each; provided, that before making the said improvement, the written consent thereto shall be given by James Canby and Samuel Canby, their heirs and assigns, and of all persons claiming under them or either of them, and that said written consent be approved of by the City Counsellor, and filed with the Register of the City of Baltimore, the consent hereby given being so given only to the extent that the Mayor and City Council may lawfully give without interfering with their rights in Franklin Square. The President of the School Board has instructed me, as a 2293 member of the Board, to ask your opinion upon a question which I shall Section 100 of the Charter of Baltimore City deals with appointments which may be made by the School Board. The last sentence of this paragraph is in the following language:-The said Board may also appoint a Supervisor of the Heating, Plumbing and Ventilation of Semonl Buildings, to be known as Supervisor of School Buildings, who shall, in addition to the supervision of school buildings in respect to their beating, plumbing and wentilating, perform such other duties as the Board The School Board wishes to know whether the authority of its Supervisor, mentioned in this paragraph, is considered by you to be con-, plete with respect to the matters of heating, plumbing and ventilation
