Where the projections or obstructions exist by wirtue of permits from the City, the permit should be first revoked, and the notice then given.

The particular cellar door on North Gay Street, ment oned by you, constitutes, I should say, a serious nuisance. It should be so reconstructed as to be made flush with the sidewalk.
