I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your favor of July 24th, transmitting report to you by Mr. Poe on the question of the service supply of the Baltimore & Ohio Railroad Company to Swift & Company. I have also discovered that they are supplying additional service to Armour & Company on Pratt street. The fact of this service being supplied by the Railroad Company was unknown to us until the poles in that locality had been stripped of the wires of other companies. It was detected through process of elimination of other wires. I am notifying the Railroad Company and also Swift & Company and Armour & Company of the fact of their illegal use of the streets in accordance with your opinion.
