I am in receipt of your letter of August 16th with the enclosure requesting a report as to whether any statutes or ordinances make it compulsory for the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore to advertise State or legal holidays.

I have made a thorough examination of the Baltimore City Code and of the Code of Public General Ordinances called to find any statute or ordinance which prescribes that there should be any advertising of any State or Municipal holiday.

I have examined both Codes under the headings "Holidays", "Legal Holidays", "Publication", "Advertising", "Notice", "Markets", "Ordinances and Resolutions" and "Mayor", and cannot find any reference to any such statute or ordinance.
