Mr. John G. Kamps, 302 S. Madeira Street, called at the office this morning and lodged complaint against the Street Cleaning Department on two charges.

First: Mr. Kamps' mother owns property at S. W. corner Pratt Street and Central Avenue, and has repeated trouble with tenants at this point who are unduly annoyed, it is alleged, by noise of street cleaners at the fire plug, nearly every night, at the work of flushing the street.

Also, Mr. Kamps claims that through careless management, or perhaps through necessity, the sidewalk at this point has been repeatedly damaged, and his mother has already spent over \$50.00 in repairs.

Mr. Kamps now wants to know, after examination of the facts, what the City is willing to do toward bearing the expense of putting the sidewalk in proper repair.
