I reply to your Secretary's communication of the 13th inst. (Circa). Mrs. Kamps, in my opinion, has no right to complain of the noise made by street cleaners in flushing the streets, provided that they make no more noise than is reasonably incident to the performance of such a task.

Any expense inflicted upon her by the operation of the Street Cleaning Department over and above the ordinary expense of keeping sidewalks in good condition, which is common to the citizens of the City generally, should, in my opinion, be borne by the City.
