Replying to your letter of the 3rd inst., I beg leave to say that, by the terms of Sec. 92 of the Charter, the Park Board is given the power from time to time to make such rules and regulations for the government of the parks, of the City as it may deem expedient. Relying upon the powers conferred by this Section, the Park Board has adopted Park Regulation No. 28, excluding all but pleasure vehicles from the Park. I regret, therefore, that I do not feel free to comply with your request.
