Dear Sir:-

6068 Your letter of the 20th instant to hand with respect to certain Annex Tax Claims. The question should be decided on the theory that the parties are now for the first time offering to pay the amount actually due by way of taxes. In this event the amount would be calculated for 1907 at sixty cents on the assessed value of the property, plus penalties and interest. Of course, in so far as the year 1908 is concerned, no penalties have as yet attached.
