I have considered the inquiry contained in the letter of  
April 24, 1908, from the Commissioner of Street Cleaning as to  
as to whether or not there is any ordinance governing the hours for  
the cleaning of Baltimore street, from Paca street to Harrison street,  
other than section 7 of article 36 of the Code of 1906.

I have examined Pielert's Code, the printed volumes of ordi-  
nances since its adoption, and the ordinances not yet printed, but  
have failed to find any other ordinance referring to the cleaning of  
Baltimore street. I do not think that section 7 of article 36 pro-  
hibits the cleaning of Baltimore street at hours other than those  
mentioned in the said section, as said section merely applies to such  
cleaning as may require the flushing of the street with water from
