Replying to your letter of the 25th inst., No. 1023, with reference to the playing of hand-organs on the streets adjacent to the Belvedere Hotel, I enclose herewith a copy of a report, dated the 28th inst., from Mr. Sylvan H. Lauchheimer, Assistant City Solicitor, to myself; and also an ordinance drafted by him, to add an additional section to article 48 of the Baltimore City Code of 1893, to be known as 154B, and regulating the use of hand-organs, street-pianos, etc. I also enclose you an ordinance drafted by him, changing the time limit within which street-pianos, etc., may not be played.

I must confess that the validity of the first mentioned ordinance is to my mind doubtful, but I consider it good policy to have the City Council pass it.

I also return herewith the letter from the President of the Belvedere Hotel Company.
