year's budget, \$1000.00 for salaries of a keeper or keepers at Carroll Park Field House where we are supposed to furnish shower baths and accommodations for athletes who use the fields there. The appropriation was made at our request, as we supposed the Park Board would erect the house for use this season, but they were unable to do this; and we learn that the Baltimore Athletic League now proposes to establish for use this season an outdoor gymnasium and field house in Carroll Park.

At Mr. Levering's suggestion, I write to ask whether we shall be authorized in offering to manage this field house as per letter enclosed. Of course, the purposes of the house will be accomplished by our work in this house supported by the Athletic League as well as in one built by the Board of Park Commissioners.

Dear Sir:

The papers reported a few days ago that your league was about to erect at Carroll Park an outdoor gymnasium, and probably a field house containing shower baths, etc., for athletes. In behalf of our Commission, I desire to say that at Carroll Park Field House our Commission is prepared to cooperate with your league to this extent, viz: if the field house is erected we shall maintain there one or two keepers, as may be necessary, and defray all expenses of management, furnishing soap, towels and all necessary equipment, for this season.
