OPINION.

LAW DEPARTMENT.

Mayor of Baltimore.

Dear Sir:-

I return herewith the ordinance authorizing the School Board to permit the use of the public schools and premises by such person or body as it may deem proper.

In my opinion this ordinance is an invalid one. The school buildings of the City are intended by the Charter to be used for school purposes, and in my judgment, the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore in its legislative capacity is powerless to authorize the School Board in its discretion to "permit any person or body to use the public school buildings and premises, or any part thereof, at such times and subject to such rules and regulations as it may deem proper." I desire you to veto the ordinance.
