Please find enclosed a petition in protest to the use of 3007 Baker Street as a hospital, with a circular printed in the Italian language issued by the physician, Doctor Aristide Giampietro.

After receiving the enclosed protest or a similar one, this Department made an investigation by the Police Department, and the report was that there were a number of beds in this house, and that the physician, Doctor Giampietro, offered to treat one of the detectives, who was looking for evidences. It was further reported that there were patients in the beds.

On September 9th, according to Section 5 of Article 16, Code of 1906, I notified Doctor Giampietro to cease using the building 3007 Baker street as a hospital. His reply to this notice is that he is not conducting this place as a public hospital, but as a private real-
