6634 I have considered the inquiry contained in the letter of Messrs.
Johnson and Millikin to the Secretary of the Mayor, in reference to
the procedure to be followed in order to secure a return of the fine and
costs which have been paid by Mr. Whiteford upon being convicted under
Section 139, Chapter 449 of the Acts of 1906, and who, upon appealing
from the decision of the Justice, was declared not guilty by Judge
Wright.
