OPINION.

Sewerage System, established by it, shall, so far as it has not already been surrendered to the charge, superintendence and control of City Officials, be then so surrendered." In my opinion, therefore, since it is your duty to see to it that the grade of the street be conformed to and the paving be restored to a proper condition, you are authorized to put such Inspectors on the work as are reasonably necessary and to charge the cost to the parties who necessitate such inspection.
