Dear Sir:-

I hand you herewith a copy of a letter that I have this day written T. Milton Jones, and have to request that if there is any way by which this man can be prosecuted and punished, for what he has done on Webster street, that proceedings be instituted against him. He has entered upon a public street, graded, curbed and paved the same, without a permit from this Department or ordinance of the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore and entirely contrary to law. He has gotten the street out of shape, not having followed the established grade, and made a mess of things generally. For me to put this street in shape at this time would necessitate two or three more steps to every house, thereby materially reducing the width of the sidewalk. Some of these houses have been sold, and when we put the street in shape, it will place serious burdens upon poor people who have ignorantly purchased these houses, erected by this man Jones.
