water; at the S.E. corner to a point 20' below mean low water; and at the N.E. corner to a point 18' below mean low water will cause the foundations to rest upon a hard sustaining stratum, sufficiently firm to sustain, in accordance with the provisions of the Building Code, the weight that the foundations are designed and intended to carry.
