I am in receipt of your letter of March 15th, regarding the removal of the pole at the northwest corner of Chase street and Collington avenue, in which you state that you will remove the pole provided the Sewerage Commission will assume the expense involved, amounting to about \$8.90.

In this connection, I beg to call your attention to the clause of the Enabling Act, printed on the removal notice sent you, which states that the removal of obstructions which block or impede the progress of the sewerage system shall be at the expense of the owner of such obstructions. Therefore, kindly have this pole removed in accordance with the terms of the Enabling Act.
