Your letter to the City Solicitor, requesting information as to the official hours within which the Commissioners for Opening Streets are presumed to be at their office, has been referred to me.

I can find no provision of law which fixes the time during which the Commissioners must be at their office; the matter, therefore, rests entirely with the Mayor to prescribe such time as he may think proper, or to prescribe no time at all, leaving it to the Commissioners to continue at their office at such times as may be necessary for the proper performance of their duties.
