My dear Sir:-

7680 As I am a bidder on storm-water contract No. 7 and consider my bid as the lowest legitimate bid, would ask that I be awarded the contract. My reason for claim of being the lowest legitimate bid is the following -

McCarthy & Company bid on items 4c, 5c and 6c, stating in writing on bidding sheet the kind of reinforced pipe to be used. If the bid was awarded, in this bid you would be forced to use that pipe or pay for other construction of higher prices, also Item 55 he does not give a price, but states in writing that the price for this item is included in price bid on items 4c, 5c and 6c, all of which is contrary to the general instructions to bidders, and if allowed to omit one price including same in another, then it would be equally allowable to make a total bid on any one item cover-
