Under date of March 24th 1909, this Department notified Mr. H. L. Thomas, who leases a piece of property belonging to the Canton Company, just East at the mouth of Harris' Creek, to repair his bulk-head, the same being in such a condition that the material behind it washes into the waters of the Harbor. Again under date of May 17th 1909, another notice was sent him to the same effect. He has refused to comply with either notice.

It is customary and obligatory for this Department each year to dredge the mouth of Harris' Creek, in order to prevent the water
