Upon examining the City Code in order to ascertain the procedure to be followed by the Harbor Board to require H. L. Thomas to repair his bulkhead, I found that Section 12 of Article 13, as amended by Ordinance 293, approved April 10th 1909, did not give the Harbor Board authority to make the repairs, in case of the failure of the owner or occupier to do so, except where the owner could not be found or was an infant.

It seems to me that the Ordinance should be amended so as to confer authority on the Harbor Board to make the repairs, in case the owner or occupier fails to comply with the notice, and that the penalty which is now imposed by the Section should be additional.

I have spoken to Mr. Lackey in reference to this, and he approves of this change. I enclose an Ordinance making the change, which may be introduced if it meets with your approval.
