I would respectfully refer you to Section 5 of the Ordinance No. 134, approved May 22nd 1908, granting to the United Fruit Company, its successors and assigns the right to exclusive use of the east half of Pier No. 1.

You will note the same covers the question of insurance, and on that point would state that the representatives of the United Fruit Company were in the office today, relative to the same, to see if some arrangements could not be made whereby they could cover the insurance to the satisfaction of the City, out of their Special Insurance Fund.
