Gentlemen:-

8321 Mr. M. B. Williams of your Board has requested that I render an opinion relative to the application of the interest earned by the fund known as the Park Tax.

Under the law, this fund is to be applied solely to the maintenance and care of the Parks and Public Squares, and cannot legally be diverted to any other purpose. I think it clear, therefore, that any interest earned by this fund should also be applied to the same purpose to which the fund, itself, is applicable, to wit: the care and maintenance of the Parks and Squares.
