These considerations would make it appear that the new Enabling Act and all of its parts are to become operative only after the loan has been ratified by the people.

There is no difficulty, however, in the way of the Sewerage Commission practically conforming to these new conditions, as indicated in the letter of the Chief Engineer to the Sewerage Commission, dated April 5th, 1910.
