We also note that you say that your sanitary sewers are nearly completed in the section bounded by Greenmount, Homewood, North avenue and Twenty-first street, but we find upon investigation that as yet no sewers have been laid between North avenue and Twentieth, and between Homewood avenue and Greenmount, the space indicated inside red line on enclosed blueprint, the nearest sewer you have laid to this section being on Greenmount avenue, south of North avenue.

As per your request, we forwarded you on September 1st, on one of your whiteprints, location of drains we own in section embraced in said print, and all these drains were located, and the Sewerage Commission subsequently had test holes dug upon them, some of which have not been refilled up to the present.

It seems to us that the drains inside the red line could be used to advantage by the Sewerage Commission, as by comparing your plan for sewerage this section, with enclosed blueprint, it appears as if our drains can be used, being as no work has been done by you yet in this section, except the digging of test holes.

We would like, therefore, to have you take this matter up, and see if our drains can be utilized, as in the section inside red line, our drains pass in rear of eighty-seven (87) houses and sixty-one (61) or about 70% are connected to our drains at the present time.

We have no drain in the rear of 517 to 535 E. Twentieth street, but are deep enough in rear of 515 E. Twentieth street to extend drain eastward in this alley and be plenty deep to take care of drainage to 535. Furthermore, all the houses that are not connected, we have Y branches on our line, set with a view of connecting them at some future time, all as indicated on enclosed print.
