You are hereby notified to bring to grade, and pave, the footway in front of your lot on the east side of Tenth street, between Beech and Piedmont avenues.

The footway is to be paved as follows:

You are further notified that you are required to do the work above specified within ten (10) days after the date of the receipt of this notice, or the City Engineer will have the work done and a tax will be imposed on your said lot to cover the cost of such work, as provided by law.
